



John Ira Hackett

March 28, 1936 - June 10, 2015

John Ira Hackett, beloved husband, father and grandfather, passed from this life into the next on June 10, 2015. He was 79 years old, born in Plymouth, WV, March 28, 1936.

He is the last surviving member of his birth family. His only brother, Jackie Paul was killed in 1953 in a tragic explosion aboard the USS Leyte. His father, Arthur passed in 1977, and his mother, Reba in 2002.

He is survived by Evelyn (Utt) Hackett, his wife of 57 years; five children and in-laws, Kim, John and wife, Debbie, Paul, Lori and husband, Greg, and Scott; four grandchildren, Ashley, James, Devin and Jack.

Following his graduation from Poca High School in 1954, John entered the US Army (PFC) and served four years, stationed as far away as Munich, Germany. After marrying in 1957, and a short station in Columbia, SC, he returned home, never living more than a few miles from his birthplace. He worked briefly for the Goodrich Rubber Plant, and spent his remaining work years as a pipefitter with Plumbers and Pipefitter Union Local # 625, a career lasting more than 35 years.

He was a lifelong Baptist and a former member of the Elizabeth Baptist Church in Bancroft. John was also active in the local Lions Club chapter for a

time and a booster supporter of the Poca High School Athletic Boosters during his children's high school years.

A memorial service and interment will be at the Haven of Rest Memorial Gardens Red House, WV on Saturday, June 13, 2015 at 11am. There will be no visitation. You may share sympathies with the family by visiting www.chapmanfuneralhomes.com.
