John William Quintrell 73, of St. Albans passed away September 12, 2016.

John was a 1961 graduate of Sissonville High School where he participated in track, weight lifting, and varsity club. The sport he excelled the most in was football. Following graduation of high school, John attended Glenville State College where he was a Football All-American from 1961-1962. John married Frances Lorraine Beane on September 14, 1963. In 1964, he began his career with Union Carbide Corp. as an operator. While employed by Carbide, John received a Bachelor's Degree from Morris Harvey College on August 18, 1967 and after 43 years of faithful service, he retired in 2007. He and Frances attended Abney Street Church of God, St. Albans.

He was preceded in death by Dolly Quintrell Taylor, Rean Taylor and faithful companion Holly.
