Joseph L. Webb, 68 of St. Albans died Monday September 2, 2013, at Hubbard Hospice House, Charleston.

Born October 11, 1944 in Ashland, Kentucky, Joseph was a son of the late Everett C. and Frances Webb. In addition to his parents, he was also preceded in death by his wife Rheada McKenzie Webb in July of 2010 and brother Rett Webb.
