Josephine Ann "Jo" White, 83, of Hurricane passed away Tuesday, May 5, 2015 at home after a long illness.

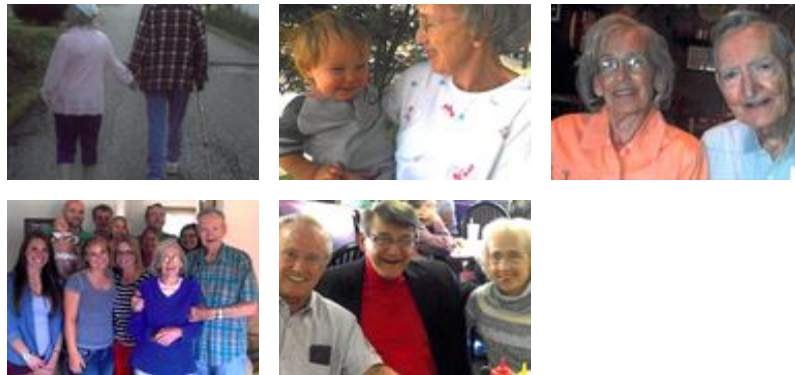
