



Pastor Larry J. Conway

September 30, 1942 - July 31, 2016

Pastor Larry J. Conway, 73 of Hurricane went home to be with his Lord and Savior Jesus Christ on Sunday, July 31, 2016.

He was born September 30, 1942 in Charleston, WV to the late Ancil Bond Conway and Violet Conway Witt. Larry was also preceded in death by his twin brother, Lendin Wayne Conway.

Those left to cherish his memory include his high school sweetheart and loving wife of 50 years, Judy Stockwell Conway. He is also survived by many nieces and nephews who adored him, and two sister-in-laws, Terry S. Keller and Sandy S. Conway.

He joined the 130th Air National Guard between his junior and senior year where he served in the reserves for nine years. He graduated from Dunbar High School in 1960 and went on to study marketing, finance and economics at West Virginia State University and earned two bachelor's degrees upon his graduation in 1969.

He began his business career as a district manager with Esso, later becoming Exxon Corporation, and later for Raybestos Brake Systems. Larry's life was changed forever when he accepted Jesus on June 4, 1974, and later baptized by Pastor Bill Bartlett of Maranatha Baptist Church. He was ordained as a

minister and became assistant pastor at Landmark Baptist Church in 1983. In December 1985 he became head pastor of Landmark Baptist where he faithfully served, ministered, and preached God's Word until the he was called to his eternal home.

A memorial service will be held at 2:00 pm, Friday, August 5, 2016 at Bartlett-Chapman Funeral Home, St. Albans with Pastor Bill Bartlett officiating.

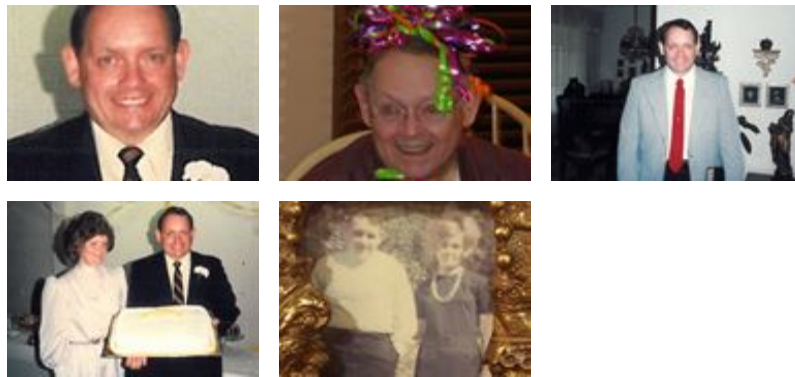
