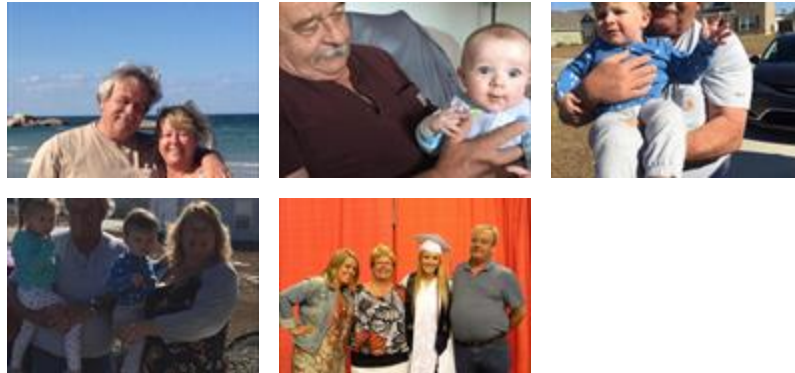
“ I first met Randy back in early 90's we both had went to work for Daniel E Needs Trucking in Columbus Ohio, we got dispatched with 3 trucks going to Salt Lake City, from Columbus Showcase with glass refrigerated cases for a new restaurant there, on our way out there Randy and Buck Wheat had very strong engines in their trucks, mine had a small diesel engine and no power, going up hills most of the time I could get 50MPH, then out in Kansas wind blowing hard from the west some place around 40 to 45 MPH my truck down on speed to 30 MPH Randy on CB hollowing at me " DAM BEECH KICK THAT THING IN THE BUTT THIS SPEED WILL TAKE ANOTHER 3 DAYS TO GET OUT THERE" Randy I am doing all this junk will do, OK Beech we will see you later we are going, they flew a pass me like jet air planes. 1 and half day later I made Salt Lake, " WHERE IN THE HELL HAVE YOU BEEN BEECH, HE WAS LAUGHING VERY HARD" " Beech we are leaving in about 4 hours get unloaded you have to go with us at the same back to Columbus" Randy I have had no sleep this Dam truck is very slow, I know it is, we will help you get back some way, Dan told me your trailer has to stay out, I told him we would junk your truck at the junk yard and you can ride with me, did you Randy? Laughter again from him, hell no you have ok get the trailer and your junk truck back there now, you leave now that way you have 4 hour head start on us, just maybe with tail wind you might get 65 Mph, get out of now, him and Buck wheat laughing. Many times through the years Randy and I have had many laughs about those days. Couple years back from now Randy was running California I met him in a truck stop not far Flag Staff on I - 40 I was pull double trailers for FED EX running team, I had went into Pilot truck stop for hot cup of coffee I saw BIG Red Setting clear in the back of truck stop, " I'll be Randy I hope" I pulled my doubles up beside of BIG Red, Randy was checking his truck getting ready to pull out, I walked up behind him OLE FRIEND I said he turned then looked at me BEECH, I BE DAM, WHAT ARE DOING OUT HERE" you driving that wiggle wagon junk, I am friend. " I should have knew, hell you'll drive any thing that is slow as hell" how fast that thing run? 65 if not facing head wind, both of us cracked up with laughter. Randy when you have to leave here, I

*was getting ready to leave, you have time to have coffee with me? Yes I do, with you anytime, we talked for almost 3 hours, he ended up late with his load and my doubles was late getting into Rialto CA, which neither of us that day cared, good close friends having some good talk and laughter very hard to find this day, but years pass was not. " I WILL MISS MY FRIEND UNTIL THE DAY I DIE, THEN JUST MAYBE THE LORD MIGHT LET US HAVE LAUGHTER AGAIN" R. I. P. OLE FRIEND UNTIL WE MET AGAIN, BEECH....*
