



## Lena "Ruth" Higgins

Lena R. Higgins, 88, of Teays Valley, WV went to be with the Lord on June 24, 2010, in Hubbard Hospice House, Charleston, WV, following a long exemplary life. Born March 10, 1922, in Glenville, Gilmer County, WV, she was the daughter of the late William Mahone Rymer and Laura Blanche Moore Rymer Dye.
