Lillian Doss Allen, 92, of Hurricane, formerly of Nitro passed away Wednesday, February 25, 2015 at Hubbard Hospice House West, South Charleston, WV.

Born April 26, 1922 in Greenville, WV (Boone County), she was a daughter of the late Sullivan Doss and Ruth Green Doss Briscoe. 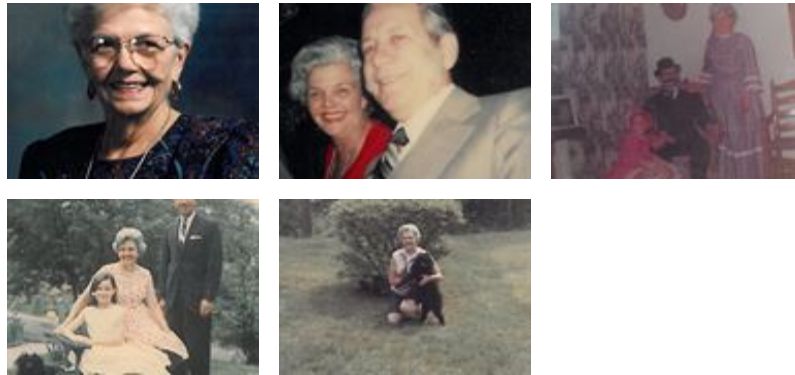

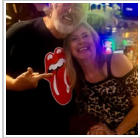

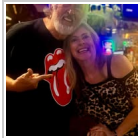
