“ To All the surviving Family of Mrs L.F. Miller. and to her immediate family. My Name is Richard Wilson & I am writing from Melbourne Australia. My Father's Brother was sgt Ralph E. Wilson. Both Ralph & Francis were flying in the same British Army plane when it crashed in heavy fog on 21st November 1941.

They were joined to the 29 Squadron.

The British Army plane had a identification number which is "Army plane number:- IF R2183".

It was a plane called .. Beaufighter Army plane. My uncle once said to me that that plane was a very "tricky plane to fly as it was unstable".

Ralph's mother who is called Gladys Charles (nee Wallington) was my grand mother. She did not want Ralph to join up and travel to the UK to fight the Germans. As she had lost 2 husbands by that time.. both due to natural causes. Both died in Dunedin NZ.

Ralph as well as his brother, (my Dad) were Born in Dundee Hospital NZ. Ralph's family were wealthy farmers in the Ranfurley Area in Central Otago South Island NZ at that time .. and owned 4 Large sheep stations that encompassed flat lands & over the mountains near by.

Ralph's Brother, John Wilson (my Dad) died of natural causes in the 1980's. My mother (age 99 and 5months) died in Melbourne recently.
