



## Marjorie McCarter Stevens

September 23, 1954 - May 24, 2022

Marjorie M. Stevens went to be present with the Lord on May 24, 2022 at the age of 67.

She is preceded in death by her parents, Roy and Leona McCarter; her brother, Michael McCarter; and sister, Ann McCann.

She was born in Jackson, Mississippi in 1954 to the late Roy and Leona McCarter, the second of their five children. Her family moved to Camp Springs, Maryland a couple years after she was born and she lived there until she went to college. 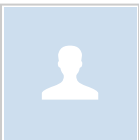
