She was very intelligent having won the Golden Horseshoe Award in the 8th grade, then graduated as the Valedictorian of Hurricane High School Class of 1987, later she graduated with a Bio Chemistry degree from University of Tennessee Knoxville and lastly earning her Juris Doctorate degree from WVU Law.
