“ Loren, David, & Leanne, so sorry about my sister, your mom. Sorry things didn't work out over the past few years. I missed her and know you will miss her. I have many good memories of her as kids. The fights we used to have, one time playing softball she was the catcher and stood too close, when I swung at the ball I hit her and knocked out one of her teeth. Getting new bicycles for Christmas, and riding them in the house. Snow ball fights, riding sleds on a hill we called Old Rocky. One year hunting Easter eggs in the snow about 3" the night before, but still we wore our new Easter Clothes. Having to take a bath in a round galvanized tub, she got hers first, then I got mine, I was always the dirtiest one. Fussing because I had to get the firewood, and carry in the coal, she laughed at me for having to do it. The time a friend of hers took my pet mouse and had a funeral for it and buried alive then couldn't find it. We dug and looked for it for an hour after they told me what they had done. It made me mad because I had to help out in the garden while she played with dolls or what ever. Taking her to school with me one day in the school year when she was 5 and didn't start until the next fall. I remember holding her hand all the way to school. Playing with a dog we called Freckles he was a bull terrier, white with black spots and pulled a cart made out of steel wheelbarrow wheel & a powder box. Too many times good times to remember. May GOD bless all of you and keep you safe.
