Melba Rae (Hildreth) Melton 70, of Hurricane, WV entered the Gates of Glory on Wednesday November 6, 2024 after a long-fought battle with Breast Cancer.

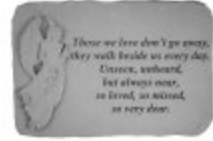
