Patrick Lee Hill, 72 of Poca passed away Monday, January 9, 2017 at Cabell-Huntington Hospital.

Born in Rensford, WV on March 17, 1944, Pat was a son of the late Otho Orville "Doc" Hill and Vonna Roberta "Bill" Sigman Hill. In addition to his parents, he was also preceded in death by infant sons, Michael David and James Anthony Hill.

Patrick served his country as a paratrooper with the 101st Airborne in the United States Army during the Vietnam War. That ideal of public service continued when he served the people of Poca as their Mayor for several terms, as an auxiliary police member and when he served on the board of the Putnam Co Parks and Rec Department. A welder by trade, "Pat" as he was known by family and friends, retired from Monsanto (flexSys) after years of faithful service. Family, Fishing, Hunting and Poca Athletics were Pat's loves. He was a founding member of the Poca River Bass Masters and loved cheering for his grandsons during their baseball and basketball games. Through that gruff voice, sly smile and twinkle in his eye, the love for his family was always apparent. He will be missed beyond measure.
