Master Sergeant Patrick Leonard Ross, Sr., 75, of Hurricane passed away Saturday, May 6, 2017 at St. Mary's Medical Center, Huntington.

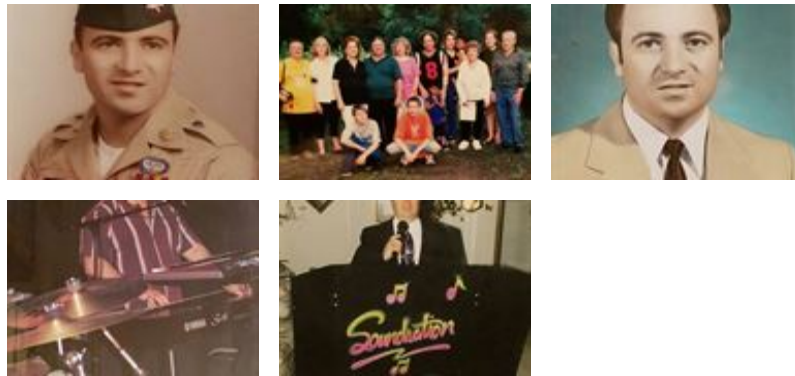
