Paul "Kenny" Milam, 54, of St. Albans, passed away Tuesday, April 7, 2014. He leaves behind his son, Paul Milam II; his brother, Scott Milam; sister-in-law, Danielle; his nephew, Colin; and mother, Barbara Milam. He was preceded in death by his father, Glen Milam.

Kenny was a graduate of St. Albans High School and was a whitewater rafting guide for 30 years in Fayetteville on both the New and Gauley River. He rafted 20 Gauley seasons, a personal goal, before leaving his passion to live in St. Albans. There he was known by neighbors as the lawnmower man and helped his elderly neighbors keep up their yard work while working nights at Lewie's video slot parlor.

Cremation arrangements are being taken care of by Bartlett-Chapman Funeral Home in St. Albans.

Kenny touched many people's lives in both Fayetteville and St Albans.

The family will hold a memorial service Wednesday, April 16, at 7 p.m. The service will be held at St. Peters United Methodist Church, 2601 Forrestal Ave., St. Albans.
