Richard K. Radcliffe, 62, passed away on Wednesday, June 6, 2018 at his home in Hurricane, WV with his family by his side.

Rick was born to Clovis (Buck) and Ruth Radcliffe in Clarksburg, WV on July 26, 1955. He graduated from Washington Irving High School and Glenville State College with a degree in Surveying. He went to work for WVDOH for a short time before starting a long career with C&P Telephone/Bell Atlantic/Verizon/Frontier until his diagnosis of an inoperable Glioblastoma Brain Tumor in late June 2015.

Rick was a member of Duff Street United Methodist Church in Clarksburg, WV. He attended St. John United Methodist Church in Scott Depot, WV. Rick was known to all of his extended family and friends as a man who could build or fix almost anything. He has helped remodel, rebuild, or repair something in almost everyone's home at one time or another. He took great pride in doing a good job and would not quit until everyone including himself was satisfied with the results. When he was not helping others, Rick enjoyed watching and attending NASCAR events, taking family vacations to Myrtle Beach, camping with his extended family and friends, and watching college football and basketball, the Tennessee Vols and Lady Vols, but most especially his beloved West Virginia Mountaineers.

Rick was preceded in death by his parents, Buck and Ruth Radcliffe, and his brother-in-law, Harvey Hardy.

He is survived by his loving wife Teri Morris Radcliffe, son Michael Radcliffe and his wife Shannon (Knoxville, TN), son Mark Radcliffe and his wife Katie (Batavia, IL), daughter Laura Casto and her companion Austin Albert (Knoxville, TN), and daughter Erica Casto (Amherst, MA).
