Robert M. Hunter, 80 of Winfield, formerly of Weirton, WV passed away Thursday, August 2, 2018 at Hubbard Hospice House, Charleston.

Born in Steubenville, Ohio, Bob was a son of the late David M. Hunter and Julia Yonko Hunter. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his twin brother, Raymond Hunter and brother, William Hunter.
