



Robert Brenner "Bob" Frincke

August 30, 1917 - April 5, 2014

Robert Brenner "Bob" Frincke, 96, formerly of Tornado, passed away Saturday April 5, 2014 in his 97th year at home in Kissimmee Florida.

Born in Charleston, West Virginia on August 30, 1917, he was the son of Rudolph Martin Frincke and Marie Brenner Frincke. He was a quiet man who accomplished much in his long life. He grew up during the depression and worked his way through university. He graduated from West Virginia University and belonged to The National Honor Societies of Tau Beta Pi, Phi Lambda Upsilon, Sigma Gamma Epsilon and the West Virginia Society of Professional Engineers.

Bob retired from Union Carbide Corp. with 40 years of service as a chemical engineer, working in Charleston, West Virginia and also time in Wales, Puerto Rico and Ireland on special assignments.

He was an active church member, President of the Lions Club, President of the PTA and worked tirelessly to have public water available to the community and served as Water Commissioner.

He volunteered during WWII and served in the Navy as a Lieutenant in active duty in the South Pacific from 1943 to 1946 and then in the Naval Reserve until 1953.

He enjoyed reading, music, traveling and excelled at fine woodworking.

He is survived by his loving wife of 66 years, Muriel Albright Frincke and their two children Winifred Collis and Robert B. Frincke, Jr., four grandchildren: Dr. Christopher R. Herlihy and his wife Dr. Ingrid Anderson, Sarah Herlihy, Robert

Frincke III, Lance Corporal Schuyler E. Frincke, one great-grandchild Lucas Herlihy, niece Marilyn Randolph and nephew David Weimer.

Funeral service will be held at 1:00 pm Tuesday, April 15, 2014 at the First Presbyterian Church, 201 Kanawha Terrace, St. Albans, with Pastor Paul D. Romine officiating. Burial will be at Sunset Memorial Park, South Charleston.
