Robert Paul "Bobby" Woodrum passed away suddenly at home in Winfield, on October 7, 2015, at age 56.

Bobby was an educator, musician, theologian, nurse, brother, father and friend, and he will be missed by all those who knew and loved him. He was a graduate of Winfield High School, West Virginia State University and the St. Mary's School of Nursing.

Bobby taught at Teays Valley Christian School for many years before entering the field of nursing at Charleston Area Medical Center where he worked until health issues forced his early retirement.

He is survived by his daughter, Hilary Woodrum, and his mother, Pat Woodrum of Winfield, as well as his older brother Joe Woodrum, Jr., his wife Elizabeth and son Joe III of Huntington and also by his brothers and their families in Winfield including brother Jim Woodrum, his wife Renee' and sons Cole and Noah and brother Bill Woodrum, his wife Lori and son Alex.

Services will be held at Chapman Funeral Home in Winfield on Sunday, October 11, 2015. Visitation will begin at 1 p.m. with service starting promptly at 3 p.m. A brief committal ceremony will follow at Winfield Town Cemetery.
