Ronald J. Hayes 74, of Hurricane, WV passed away on February 20, 2024 at home in his favorite recliner after fighting a long and courageous battle with cancer.

He was preceded in death by his son, Andrew; parents: John and Wilda (Boso) Hayes; sister, Rebecca Powers; and brothers: Harry and John Dennis Hayes.

Ron was a 1968 graduate of Hurricane High School and WV Tech where he was a member of Sigma Pi fraternity. After graduation from WV Tech, he worked at WVDOT, Dawson Bridge Company, GE Ray and his final and most proud job was President of Teays River Construction.

During his younger years, Ron was involved in Midget Football, umpired many baseball games and coached Midget basketball. Ron held the chains for Hurricane High School football games for 50+ years and received the WSAZ Hometown Hero in 2020. Ron made many long lasting friendships during his lifetime, but one special friend was his buddy, Bruce Casto. Ron was a member and deacon at First Baptist Church of Hurricane and a member of Sleepy Hollow Golf Course.

Ron is survived by his wife of 49 years, Sherry Troyer Hayes; son, Adam

(Ami); grandchildren: Eva, Scarlett and his little buddy, Drew; and his twin brother, Donald Hayes (Jackie); as well as several nieces and nephews.
