Ross E. Gilson, 91, of Red House, died peacefully at Hubbard Hospoice House West on Friday, June 17, 2016.

Ross was born in Wheeling, WV on June 14, 1925. He proudly fought for his country during World War II, serving on the SS Lee S. Overman in the European Theater. After his service, Ross returned to West Virginia, where he married his bride of 62 years, Bettie. Ross was a retiree of Union Carbide. He faithfully served his Lord for many years at Riverside Baptist Church and later at Poca Baptist Church.

Ross was an avid sports fan who never missed his grandsons' many baseball and basketball games. His favorite sports teams were the ones his grandsons loved, particularly the Pittsburgh Pirates and the Duke University Blue Devils.
