Russell Douglas Hauldren Sr., 93 of Winfield, passed away January 9, 2018 at his residence.

Russell, a lifelong resident of Putnam County, was a son of the late, James Walter Hauldren and Amanda Burke Hauldren. In addition to his parents, Russell was preceded in death by his beloved wife, Betty Frances Hauldren and sisters, Gertrude Ball and Ruby Pitts.

He served his country with the Army Air Force in both World War II and Korea. A bus driver by trade, Russell retired from Charleston Transit with 19 years of service and Putnam County Schools with 19 years of service. When talking about the students he cared for on his bus route, Russell always referred to them as "his little angels".
