Samuel Charles Harris Jr. passed away Thursday, September 27, 2012 in Charleston. He was 95 years old. Mr. Harris, married to the former Eulalah Van Fleet of Romney, was a retired chemist with American Viscose Corporation (later FMC. Corp.) in Nitro. Born in Fairmont to the late Charles S. Harris and Mabel (Feather) Harris, Mr. Harris was a graduate of Fairmont State College with a Bachelor's degree and earned a Master's degree in Chemistry from West Virginia University in Morgantown. Early in his career, Mr. Harris was an instructor of chemistry at Waynesburg College, Waynesburg, PA. He and his wife of 74 years had lived in the home built by Mr. Harris and his father some 70 years ago. Mr. Harris, a member of the American Chemical Society, Zeta Sigma Fraternity and Covenant Presbyterian Church in Nitro, was Supervisor of Quality Control for American Viscose Corporation until his retirement. An avid fisherman, gardener, amateur photographer and enthusiastic world traveler, Mr. Harris provided gentle council and unfailing loving support to his family and friends. He never ceased showing an interest in or listening to others' stories and quietly offered his help whenever chores needed to be done at church, home or work. Mr. Harris is survived, in addition to his wife, by two brothers, William E. Harris and wife, Velma, of Ripley and Harold E. Harris of Fairmont, nephews Charles, Duane, Timothy and Steven Harris and several nieces, sister-in-law Betty Van Fleet Shelly and husband, Don of Greenwood, SC, nephew William F. Kuykendall and wife Mary of Winterport, ME, grand-nephew (and

namesake) Samuel L. Kuykendall of Old Town, ME, grand-nephew Adam Kuykendall and wife, Kathleen of Brewer, ME and great-great niece, Lucy E. Kuykendall. Funeral service will be 2 p.m. Tuesday, October 2, 2012 at Covenant Presbyterian Church, 424 Cross Lanes Rd. Nitro, with Pastor John H. Rollins, Jr. officiating.
