Samuel Madison Shafer, 56, of Winfield, passed away on August 2, 2023, surrounded by family.

Sam was a proud 1985 graduate of Hurricane High School. After high school he enlisted in the US Army. Many stories were told by him about his time abroad, especially during his time in Italy. After leaving the military in 1988, Sam traveled the United States working in nuclear power plants. Next, he began his employment with IUOE Local 132 as a crane operator. Cranes became his life's work, and he enjoyed pointing out places he helped build to friends and family.

With family, he enjoyed fishing and kayaking. He took many fishing trips around the state with his nephews and friends. He looked forward to traveling south in the summers, especially when a large group of friends and family went together. History was a passion, and he enjoyed learning about alien life, both past and present and anyone close knew he would do his best to convince you that it was real.

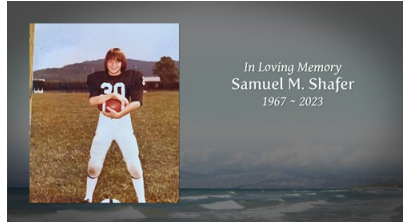
