Sherri Lynn Pinnell, 56, of St. Albans passed away Wednesday, January 06, 2016 at her home.

Born May 25, 1959, in Beckley, Sherri was a daughter of Beulah “Boots” Pinnell of St. Albans and the late Robert J. Pinnell. She was also preceded in death by her paternal grandparents, Warren and Texie Pinnell.
