Sidney Garland Pack, 95, of Cross Lanes went home to be with the Lord on Monday, June 26, 2017 at his residence.

He was born in Pearisburg, Virginia to the late Karl and Laura Elmore Pack. He was also preceded in death by 6 other brothers and sisters.

Sidney retired from Union Carbide Corp. as a supervisor with 43 years of service. He was a member of the Cross Lanes Baptist Church.

He was a Past Master of the South Charleston Masonic Lodge # 168 A.F. & A. M. and also Past Worthy Patron of the Order of the Star, Chapter # 131, South Charleston. He was a U S Army veteran of World War II where he received the Purple Heart, a Bronze Star, President Citation and held the rank of Corporal.
