Theodore Sterling Evans, Jr., 82 of St. Albans went to his Heavenly home, Tuesday, April 5, 2016.

Born December 13, 1933 in Williamstown, WV, her was a son of the late Theodore Sterling Evans, Sr. and Crystal Uhl Evans. He was also recently preceded in death by his brothers, Dan and Bob Evans. Also preceding him in death are brothers-in-law, Everette, Cecil, Joe and Ronald and sister-in-law, Sarah.

He was a graduate of Charleston High School, completed his undergraduate work in Christian Education at Morris Harvey College and his Master's degree in the same field at Wesley Seminary, Washington, DC.

Sterling began his career serving the youth ministries of the United Methodist Church at St. Mark's UMC, Charleston. Following graduation from Wesley, he served two churches in the Washington, DC area before returning to his beloved West Virginia and served as Youth Minister at St. Andrew UMC until his retirement. Following, he worked as a clerk at the former Cokesbury Church and Book Supply, Charleston.

Currently worshipping at St. Peter's United Methodist Church, St. Albans, Sterling holds the honor of being one of the first Diaconal Ministers

consecrated by the WV Conference of the UMC. He also served as an associate director of the WV Annual Conference Council on Ministry, focusing on youth and children. His efforts of “thinking out of the box” allowed him to teach and encourage the participation of his church youth groups.

Surviving him are his wife, Freda H. Evans; his son, Ted Evans of St. Albans; his sister, Rebecca Bailey of Winston-Salem, NC; nieces, Lynn Bailey and D’Ann Hershel and nephews, Mike and Chris Evans. Also surviving are his brother-in-law and sisters-in-law, David Harris of Bluefield, WV, Marjorie Hartley and Frances Taylor both of Bluefield, VA, Anna Fry of Fort Worth, TX as well as their children.

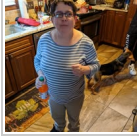
