Morning has broken and Thomas Patton Barron, 80 of Hurricane has ascended into Heaven on Sunday June 11, 2017 at Thomas Memorial Hospital, South Charleston.

Born in Eccles, WV, Thomas was a son of the late Robert Patton Barron Sr. and Monette Collier Barron. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his brother, Robert Patton Barron Jr.

Thomas Barron was a lovable man and he truly lived by Jesus' commandment to love one another. It has been said that he was always in a good mood and showed his love by giving hugs.

He graduated from Trap Hill High School where he excelled in football and basketball. Following graduation, he went to Beckley Junior College on a basketball scholarship. Thomas later graduated from West Virginia Tech and began his career as a draftsman with Union Carbide. He gradually made his way up the ranks to lead engineer, and retired after 40 years of faithful service.

Thomas was devout in Christ and was a long-time member of Teays Valley Presbyterian Church, where he served as Elder, Sunday school teacher and as a shepherd.
