Thomas Wendell Cyrus, 63, of Culloden, WV, entered God's kingdom on May 3, 2024.

He was born on October 14, 1960, to the late Daymound E. and Bessie G. Byrd Cyrus.

Thomas, a man of honor and service, proudly served his country in the United States Air Force at the age of 22. He was trained as a construction equipment operator assigned to the 44th Civil Engineering Squadron, a role that laid the foundation for his successful civilian career as a heavy equipment operator with United Steelworkers Union Local 14614. His recent retirement marked the end of a fulfilling chapter in his life.

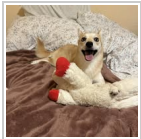
