Thomas Vincent Reishman of Hurricane passed away Sunday, December 18, 2011. He was preceded in death by his father, William J. Reishman. He is survived by his mother, Joan Reishman of Kanawha City; wife, Nancy E. Reishman of Hurricane; son, Harrison Wade Reishman of Los Angeles, Calif.; and daughter, Allison Marie Reishman of Atlanta, Ga. He is also survived by his brother, William Reishman (Pat) of Oregon; sister, Nancy Bonifacic (Tony) of Louisiana; and brother, Charles Reishman (Judy) of Missouri; as well as many nieces, nephews, cousins and friends. Tom graduated from West Virginia University with a bachelor's degree in economics. He had a long career working for the State of West Virginia, which including: positions as a research economist with the West Virginia Commission on Energy, Economy & Environment; a similar role in the West Virginia Fuel and Energy Office; an analyst in the Governor's Office of Economic and Community Development; a market analyst and marketing director at the West Virginia Coal Development Authority; and Deputy Commissioner of The Department of Energy, at which time he was honored as a "Distinguished West Virginian". He later became the founder, owner and president of Orion Resources, Inc., from 1992 to 2010. Tom was most recently chief operating officer of the West Virginia Regional Technology Park located in South Charleston. The visitation will be from 6 to 8 p.m. Wednesday, December 28, at Chapman Funeral Home, Teays Valley. The funeral service will be the following morning, December 29, at 10:00am at the Ascension Catholic Church in Hurricane. A private burial of the cremains
