He enjoyed tailgating in the RV lot with many other Mountaineer fans, who would gather around to enjoy one of his famous “Tangers” made by his equally famous 2 cycle blender! He lost his voice many times cheering on the Mounties, which according to several people, wasn’t necessarily a bad thing.

Three years ago Tim found a brand new passion. His Grandson, Jacob. He was the light of his life and couldn’t wait to spend time with him. Tim had just recently returned from a trip up to Massachusetts visiting him, his daughter, and several friends before his passing.
