



## Toka Evelyn Field

November 1, 1921 - March 23, 2015

Toka Evelyn Field, 93, passed away Monday, March 23, 2015, at Broadmore Senior Living in Hurricane.

Born Nov. 1, 1921, in Boone County, she was a daughter of the late Dennis and Myrtle Cline Wade.
