Troy Wilford Auvil, 77, a 46 year resident of Scott Depot, went home to be with the Lord on January 17, 2012 after a short illness. Troy was born January 17, 1935 in Leadmine, Tucker County. He was the eldest son of the 12 children of the late Rena James and Troy William Auvil of Aurora. In addition to his parents, Troy was preceded in death by two of his younger brothers Norman and Dorian Auvil. He graduated from Aurora High School in 1953. He attended West Virginia University, and graduated from Potomac State College and West Virginia State College. Troy retired from Union Carbide/Rhone Poulenc as a certified electrician after 42 years of maintenance service on instrumentation and refrigeration equipment. Troy was a 37 year member of the Nitro Masonic Lodge #170 A.F. & A.M. He was a 40 year veteran of the International Association of Machinists, the Aerospace Workers Lodge #656, and the NRA. Troy was a Christian, and a member of St. John United Methodist Church, Scott Depot.
