Wendell Clyde “Paddlefoot” Thevenin, 75, of Cross Lanes, formerly of Winfield, passed away on April 4, 2016 at Hubbard Hospice House, Charleston.

He was the only son born to the late Donald Clyde and Westie Clovicie Watson Thevenin on October 27, 1940 in Winfield WV. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his sisters, Arlene Fewell and Donna Summers.
