William Merritt Whitten, 86 of Hurricane passed away August 1, 2017 at St. Mary's Medical Center, Huntington.

"Bill" as he was known by family and friends, was born in Leon, Kentucky and was a son of the late James Merritt Whitten and Floramel Foit Whitten Myers. In addition to his parents, Bill was preceded in death by his sister Wanda McNeill and son-in-law, John Williamson.

He retired from Union Carbide Corp as a chemical production specialist after 42 years of faithful service. It is very well-known among family and friends that wherever you saw Bill, he was usually driving and Janet was always right there with him.
