



## Winsdor Clenton Adams Sr.

June 13, 1925 - January 1, 2015

Mr. Winsdor Clenton Adams, Sr. died peacefully, surrounded by his family, in the Veterans Administration Regional Medical Center on January 1, 2015 in Salem, Virginia at the age of 89.

Winsdor was born on June 13, 1925 in Bluestone, West Virginia. A veteran of World War II, he was wounded in action in Germany in 1945 and was awarded the Bronze Star and Purple Heart.

A long time resident of Winfield, he was an active and dedicated member of St. John United Methodist Church in Scott Depot. His devotion to his family and his firm belief in God supported him in his struggle and ultimately gave him peace.

Winsdor is survived by his wife of 65 years, Hannah Rose Adams of Roanoke, Virginia; son, W.C. Adams, Jr., and daughter-in-law, Kelly Adams, of Vinton, Virginia, daughter, Laura Jeanette Eggleton, and son-in-law James Eggleton, of Columbia, South Carolina, grandchildren, Kim Shirkey, of Scott Depot, Aaron Johnson and wife, Bonnie of Austin, Texas, and Lindsey and husband, J.R. Collins of Scott Depot, and 7 great-grandchildren, Christopher, Katelyn, Aspen, Sydney, Cameron, Chandler and Tripp. He is preceded in death by his parents, O'Dell Vaughn Adams and Laura Tabitha (Martin) Adams of Bluestone.

A service is scheduled for Monday, January 5, 2015 at 12:00 p.m. at St. John United Methodist Church in Scott Depot. The family will receive friends prior to the service beginning at 10:00 a.m. Reverend Martin Hallett will officiate the ceremony. All are welcome to attend and celebrate Winsdor's life.
