Zachary Joseph Thompson was born in Charleston, West Virginia on March 25, 1965 to the parents of Barbara (Bobby) and Reverend Benton T. Thompson Jr. (BT). Zachary was the youngest of nine children; Larry, Tyrone, Nina, Randolph, Phyllis, Debbie, Carol, Benton III.

On August 16, 2020 Zachary Joseph Thompson was called home by the Lord.

He was preceded in death by his father, Reverend Benton T. Thompson Jr.; mother, Barbara Thompson; brother, Larry Johnson; four sisters, Debbie Thompson, Carol Thompson, Nina Shipp, and Phyllis Willis.

Zack's honorable work experience spanned more than 35 years in careers with the International Union of Elevator Constructors, United Brotherhood of Carpenters and Joiners of America, as well as, the West Virginia Supreme Court of Appeals. His work allowed him to share his knowledge of the state while traveling with friends and family.

Funeral services for Zack will be 1:00pm Saturday, August 22, 2020 at Chapman Funeral Home, Hurricane, West Virginia with Rev. Benton T. Thompson, III officiating. Burial will follow in Spring Hill Cemetery, Charleston WV.

The family will receive visitors Saturday from 12 noon until 1:00pm at the funeral home.
